### Summary

CHARTS is looking to create a bank of photographers who may be available over the coming year to document our work across the region. If you are an experienced professional photographer, we would be delighted to hear from you and will alert you should opportunities arise in your area. As a registered charity, we fund all of our work through restricted budgets, and we aim to contact photographers to document work as project funds allow.

We operate throughout Argyll and Bute and would invite photographers resident in all council areas to contact us.

This role may also include close working with other Argyll and Bute arts and heritage stakeholders, and invitations to work for us in this role will generally vary in duration, lasting 1-2 days per project.

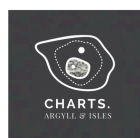
